Financial Statute No. 17 of 1990

ORDER UNDER SECTION 5(1)

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 5(1) of the Finance Statute, No. 17 of 1990 Provincial Council, Central Province, I, Weerasooriya Dissanayake Mudiyansele Panchi Banda Dissanayake, Chief Minister and Minister of Finance, Law and Order, Provincial Administration, Planning, Land, Local Government and Education, Central Province Provincial Council do by this order with effect from 17th November, 1995, declare the following business to be exempt from turnover tax:-

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 7(1) of the Financial Statute, No. 17 of 1990 Provincial Council of the Central Province, I, Weerasooriya Dissanayake Mudiyansele Panchi Banda Dissanayake, Chief Minister and Minister of Finance, Law and Order, Provincial Administration, Planning, Land, Local Government and Education of the Central Province Provincial Council do by this order amend with effect from 17th November, 1995, the orders made under Section 7(1) published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 642/18 of 28th December, 1990 as follows:-
